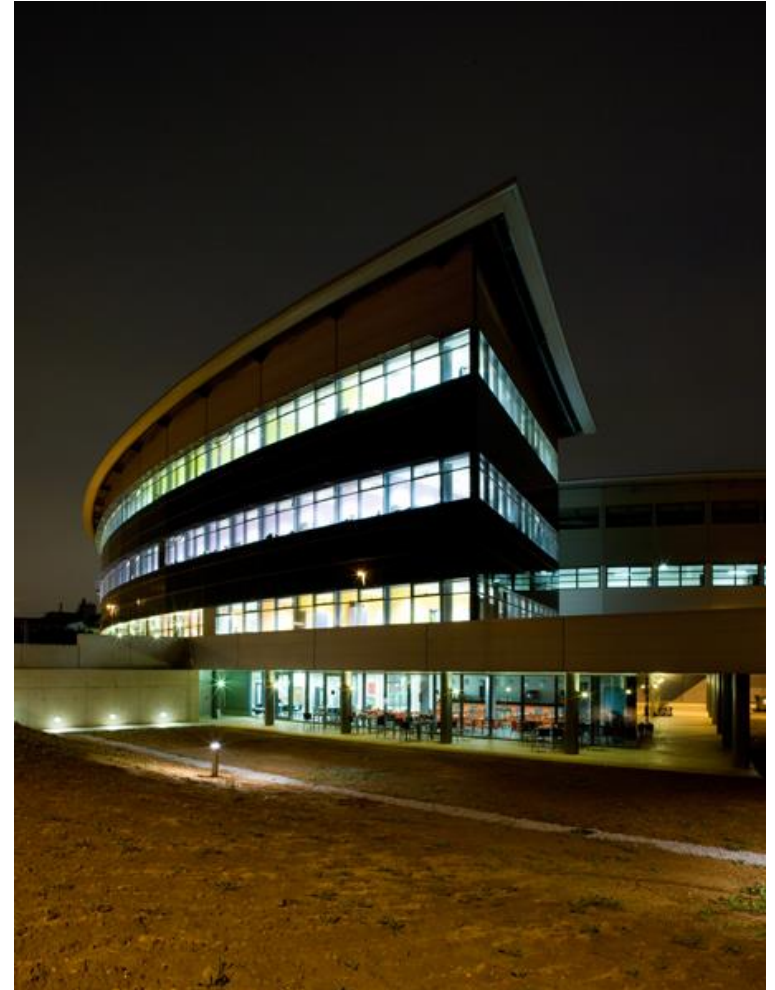

- 8 Beamlines in full operation
- 2 calls each year
- ~400 proposals per year (200 p/call)
- 2 Beamlines WiP:
  - LOREA (Angular Resolved Photoemission) in Installation Phase. Operation expected in 2018.
  - XAIRA (Micro PX) in Design Phase.

- Already available at the User Office Portal
- Since June 22nd of 2016 (3 months now).
- Number of users on the Portal: **2907**
- Number of users having the Umbrella account linked: **4**

- Best practices:
  - Fullest possible description of the raw data: Alba-CELLS undertakes to provide means, on a best effort basis, for the capture of a complete metadata set,
  - The experimental team is encouraged to ensure that experimental metadata are as complete as possible
  - PIs and researchers who carry out data analysis are encouraged to link the results with the raw data and ultimately they are encouraged to make such results publicly accessible.

- ALBA haven't published the final version yet.
- Draft content:
  - All raw data and the associated metadata obtained as a result of public (non-proprietary) access to Alba-CELLS reside in the public domain, with Alba-CELLS acting as the custodian, and with **access restricted during an “embargo” period of 3 years.**
  - All raw data and the associated metadata obtained as a result of proprietary access to Alba-CELLS will be owned exclusively by the proprietary user. Permissions and relevant procedures are in place to guarantee the confidentiality.
  - Raw data may or may not be curated at Alba's premises.
  - **Alba-CELLS shall custody the data for a minimum of 6 months.** Thereafter it will be removed or kept longer time, even beyond the 3-year embargo period. **Access to raw data and the associated metadata obtained from an experiment is restricted to the experimental team for 3 years.** After the embargo is over, the data and metadata will become publicly accessible. Any PI that wishes their data not to become “publicly accessible” for a longer period will be required to make a **special case to the Director of Alba-CELLS.**
