The abstract submission for the 5th International Workshop on the
Physics of fundamental Symmetries and Interactions – PSI2019 –
 to be held at the Paul Scherrer Institute (PSI), Switzerland, October 21-25, 2019, is now open.

Scientific program

The workshop focuses on the physics at the low energy, high precision frontier without neglecting complementary approaches. It aims at highlighting present activities and future developments and will consist solely of plenary sessions. It will include invited overview presentations to main topics, recent experimental results, and a dedicated poster session central to the scientific discussion at the workshop including a poster award sponsored by NuPECC.

Scientific topics include:

- Low energy precision tests of the Standard Model
- Experiments with muons, pions, neutrons, antiprotons, other particles and atoms
- Searches for permanent electric dipole moments
- Searches for symmetry violations and new forces
- Precision measurements of fundamental constants
- Exotic atoms and molecules
- New tools and facilities
