Outstanding posters presented at the workshop will be awarded by a "HEARING Poster Award". The posters will be presented during entire duration of the workshop, and both the committee members and the audience will select the winning posters. The choice will be based on "scientific excellence", the "presentation of the scientific information on the poster" as well as the "presentation of the presenting author". All conference attendees will have the opportunity to vote for the best poster. Once all votes are collected, the poster with the most votes will be awarded the poster prize.
