



### Overview of 2022 and 2023

- 2022: 14 presentations (10 talk, 4 poster), 2023: 10 presentations to October (10 talks)
  - Good (?) number for an experiment in the design phase
- Distribution of talks by institute shows some of the most active groups, but not all of them
- Distribution by career stage favors postdocs and scientists good (?) ("Scientists" may include large spread
  of seniority)
- Exact conferences; topical focus; invited or contributed talk can be viewed on the Conferences TWiki page





# Repositories and list of talks: conference presentations

- Currently: Twiki page and DocDB
  - Both are access-restricted, not reachable for the public
  - DocDB is not very convenient for storing materials in a structured way and finding/accessing talks
- Suggestion: list of talks (including slides, at least link to slides) will be posted and updated on a subcategory of the new PIONEER webpage
  - Easy to find and access for the interested community, including possible new collaborators
  - Most talks are uploaded to publicly viewable pages (e.g. Indico) in any case

## Repositories and list of talks: seminars

- Planning to have a similar list of seminars, colloquia, smaller talks given at institutes
  - What should be included here anything from high-profile CERN or FNAL seminars, to extended institute or group meetings?
  - Where to keep said list and slides? Some of these could be public, but perhaps not all and not by default

 Suggestion: List similar to the Conferences list on TWiki for the time being, some selected materials could be posted on the PIONEER website or mentioned in the News/Updates section

# Repositories and list of talks: materials

- Speakers, especially when not experts in a specific area, are often looking for the newest updated models or plots to include in talks and PIONEER overviews
- No dedicated area so far for keeping and distributing such presentation materials
  - DocDB is not convenient for storing materials in a structured way, hard to navigate especially if one does not know to detail what to look for, does not have integrated viewer
  - eLog is meant for logging active work, not for being a repository for polished results
- Suggestion: expand subgroup pages in Twiki, and/or create pages for most recent status and 'approved plots' with useful material and related documentation
  - Easy way to store and navigate materials for use in talks, but not directly post for public access

### Author lists

- Current situation: include everyone in the original PSI proposal author list with additions over time, nobody has been removed unless explicitly retreated themselves
- Latex author list maintained ~manually by Patrick
- Publications have mostly been conference proceedings of a specific topic with a short PIONEER introduction and overview, e.g. An LGAD-based Active Target Detector for the PIONEER Experiment
  - Main author / active team has decided named authors, list is displayed as A. Author, B. B-author, C. C-author... on behalf of the PIONEER Collaboration
  - Has worked well in practice, reflects active contribution to a degree, "nobody has complained"
- Two main purposes: funding proposals and research proposals; presentations and publications
  - Somewhat different objectives: evaluating and demonstrating interest vs acknowledging contribution
- Eventually there should be formal guidelines at least recommendations on how to determine authorship to aim at fair inclusion and recognition
  - > Largely up to the Institutions Board
  - > Suggestions: a) set guidelines for author status, b) consider the possibility for separate author lists, based on interest vs based on active contributions
