The Past



A Long Time Ago...


Well co-ordinated access control is a crucial issue for the VCS project, requiring ar Authentication/Authorisation Infrastructure (AAI) SWITCH proposes a one-year mandate to study and design an AAI that suits the needs of the VCS as well as further projects within universities and for collaborations with foreign institutions. The activities within the scope of this mandate will be funded by SWITCH. An AAI deployment will be proposed in follow-up mandates jointly with the universities.

The Use Case for AAI

- Swiss Virtual Campus (2000-2003 & 2004-2007)
- Subsidies for university projects with Principal Goal: «develop teaching modules that will be used through the Internet in several regular study programs of the Swiss universities»
 - Users from multiple universities needed to be able to access any of the e-learning platforms
 - Authentication across security domains
 - All universities were involved






Proposed Solution: AAI

AAI as a Federation




Federation: Common trust, standards and policies



SWITCHaai Federation

SWITCH consults with two bodies:

- Advisory Committee
 deals with policies and
 legal framework
- Community Group
 deals with technical/operational issues





Two categories of SWITCHaai Participants:

- SWITCH Community
 Organization fits the definition from the SWITCH Service Regulations. E.g. Universities, research institutions
- <u>Federation Partner</u>
 Organization sponsored by a SWITCHaai Participant from the SWITCH Community. E.g. Microsoft, Elsevier




SWITCHaai: Services Provided

- Rules, policies and agreements
- Documentation: installation/migration guides, How-Tos
- Call-in helpdesk and support mailing list
- Centralized Services
 - Discovery Service, Attribute Viewer
 - Resource Registry (metadata management)
 - Virtual Home Organization (VHO), Guest Login (for homeless)
 - Group Management Tool, Toolbox (solution for VOs)
- Shibboleth IdP plugins: uApprove, x.509 login, kerberos login
- Test federation
- Some application integration support
- Training (hands-on workshops)
- Identity Provider Hosting

- Was internationally driven from the start
 - Developed by GEANT


- eduroam is about authentication only
 - No user attributes available


Hierarchical Radius architecture












(Minimum) AAI Authentication Requests





SWITCHaai Attribute Release

- Completely automated attribute release:
 - Attribute release is managed via Resource
 Registry web interface by IdP administrators
 - Default rules are applied to new SPs
 - IdPs download attribute release rules hourly
 - Administrators get automatically informed of changes and can create specific rules
- Attribute release issues are very rare!

SWITCHaai Success Factors

- Virtual Campus Switzerland funding
 - Subsidies required cooperation
- Acceptance due to Involvement
 - Close collaboration with universities during development of AAI
- Critical Mass
 - Participation of large universities accelerated adoption rate
 - AAI became a self-runner

Status of eduroam

From 46 Swiss Higher Education Organisations:

- 32 (69%) support eduroam
- 5 planned or in progress
- 9 no plans not planned

Development of eduroam in Switzerland compared to AAI

 Smaller coverage and slower adoption in Switzerland compared to AAI


- Partly due to alternatives:
 - Universities mutually allow access to their VPN concentrators
 - open Wifi (like here at PSI)

Monitoring with AMAAIS

- No accurate user statistics currently in a meshed federation like SWITCHaai
- Only IdPs have accurate statistics





Growth on National Level

- Coverage in Higher Education is 98%
- Upper secondary students are the future university students
- Swiss Cantons can join AAI for Upper Secondary as Federation Partner
- Requires an Identity Management for Upper Secondary users
- Specific interest known from 5 of 26 cantons

Growth on International Level

- Most AAIs use/also support SAML2
 - Policies and architectures slightly differ

 Some university services are already part of other federations/bilaterally configured

There is a natural move and a need for Interfederation




Interfederation

 Users get access to services registered in other federations

 eduGAIN is the interfederation service of GÉANT

 Rules and Guidelines regar international data protection are still under debate





European Countries with eduroam

eduroam also available in countries:

- North America
- South America
- APAN



Moonshot = eduroam + AAI

- Completely new technology consisting of already known technologies (SAML, Radius, EAP, GSS-API, SASL,...)
- Potential solution for non-browser apps
 - Take the best from eduroam (non-browser support) + AAI (attributes)

Moonshot pilot starts in April

Summary

 Involving the universities helped AAI to get accepted and become successful faster

 International research projects face similar issues like Virtual Campus Switzerland 10 years ago

 AAI in Switzerland needed about 3 years to reach critical mass
