

## Commuting to the PSI

The Paul Scherrer Institut is well connected by public transport with buses from Brugg AG and Siggenthal - Würenlingen station as well as to the surrounding villages during morning and evening rush hours.

### How many tickets do I need?

- 3 days return (1st, 3rd and 4th July)
- 1 single on Wednesday morning 2nd July  
(a courtesy bus service after the dinner to your accommodation will be arranged).

### Where can I buy the bus tickets?

- from the bus driver (guests from abroad)
- at the ticket machines
- at the railway ticket counters (guests from abroad)
- [online www.sbb.ch](http://www.sbb.ch) (Swiss residents – delivery requires 3 working days)  
Please order in the ticket shop under “Regional fare networks”, “A-Welle” etc.

### Cheapest option (example below based on full fare Brugg to PSI West)

- **1 stamp card with 6 SINGLE trips** (pay 5 get 6 trips)  
(covers 1st, 3rd and 4th July – CHF 23.00 full fare)
- **1 single individual ticket**  
(for 2nd July in the morning – CHF 4.60 full fare)



You save CHF 4.60 compared to buying 7 individual full fare tickets.

### Please bear in mind

- Single trip tickets are valid for 1 hour only
- **Multiple-journey stamp cards have to be punched by**
  - an orange “box” at the station or
  - at a ticket machine or
  - in the bus (see pictures below)**at the start of each trip in order to avoid a fine.**
